

Fujion



Fruit:

Similar to Fuji with an intense red colour and well-defined stripes over almost the entire surface. It is round and slightly elongated, very regular and more consistent in size than Fuji. The flesh is crispy, juicy and intensely sweet, generally sweeter than Fuji. Up to now no storage physiological or pathological disorders have been found.

Tree:

With good habit, moderately vigorous and easy to manage. Precocious fruit bearing with high productivity and no biennial bearing problems. Resistant to scab. Harvest period more concentrated than for Fuji and can generally be completed in two pickings.

Ripening time:

- 3 days before Fuji
